While recently going through cherished mementoes, I uncovered a 2004 letter from "Manuel" addressed to "Boys and Girls Club Staff, Administration, Office Staff and Club Members," thanking the Indio Club for being the vehicle that set him on the right path. The Club was the only child care option for Manuel, who was being raised by his single, working mother of three. Not having a father around, Manuel was looking for a positive role model. He found that guiding light in three adult male Club mentors.

Mentor #1 spent so much time with Manuel that he was lovingly chided by his Club mates with the typical "Who's your daddy" jokes. That mentor weight-lifted with Manuel every day, strengthening not only his physical body but boosting his mental health with improved self-esteem and confidence while developing a witty sense of humor.



Mentor #2 taught Manuel the joy of discovery through books. In Manuel's own words, "I proudly won reader of the month, and several times I may add." He attributes both his academic and career success as an Educator (with a Masters in Educational Counseling) to this early literary exposure.

Mentor #3 exemplified "intelligence and well-

roundedness," sparking Manuel's interest in wanting to emulate him. They spent many hours together shooting the breeze and hoops, but also discussing their in-common studies of the human mind. They also discussed Manuel's college experiences and progress toward accomplishing his personal goals. Because Manuel observed his mother's many sacrifices at home, he learned life-changing lessons and was able to overcome major obstacles. In reflection, he recognized and appreciated how his second home, the Club, helped him become the man and success story he is proud of to this day:

"I was able to achieve great things because I took responsibility for my life. I wanted to be somebody more than wanting to be nobody."

Manuel closed his correspondence by again thanking everyone in the letter's salutation, wanting them all to know they would live in his memory forever.

I just love this letter because it also tells the story about the dedicated men and women who pour their hearts and souls into this organization.
