With the help from state and local grant-funding, new this summer will be the addition of a weekly onsite therapist to help our kids and their families deal with mental health challenges. Many of our existing

programs like Triple Play and Healthy Habits have already helped our kids combat health/behavior issues by helping them to be more active physically, socially and emotionally. Understanding the prevalence of trauma and adversity and how that impacts health and behavior is a topic we may all be learning more and more about as research continues.



BGC of CV is partnering with Innercare Youth Mental Health Collaborative to conduct Adverse Childhood Experiences screenings at the Clubhouses, train staff members in Trauma Informed Care practices, and work alongside Club Unit Directors to identify at-risk youth and connect them to a licensed therapist and/or social worker.
