

TONY REAGINS ALUMNI ASSOCIATION

Since 2007, the Tony Reagins Alumni Association has provided college scholarships to deserving Club alumni through its annual golf tournament. Comprised of Boys & Girls Clubs of Coachella Valley alumni, the association is a prime example of how generosity begets generosity.

Former Indio Club member and contemporary success story, Tony Reagins, launched the tournament in 2013. He is Major League Baseball's Executive Vice President of Baseball and Softball Development. Additionally, Tony has joined the Board of Directors for Boys & Girls Clubs of America as an advocate for youth across the nation.

Over the last 6 years, proceeds from the golf tournament has netted \$161,000 to fund 57 college scholarships to Boys & Girls Clubs youth. Most of the recipients are first generation college students studying primarily in the fields of technology, engineering, medicine, education, and law. At the May 2019 tournament, two scholarship graduates were able to express their gratitude for the financial assistance that helped one obtain a Masters degree in Psychology and the other a B.A. in Criminal Justice.
